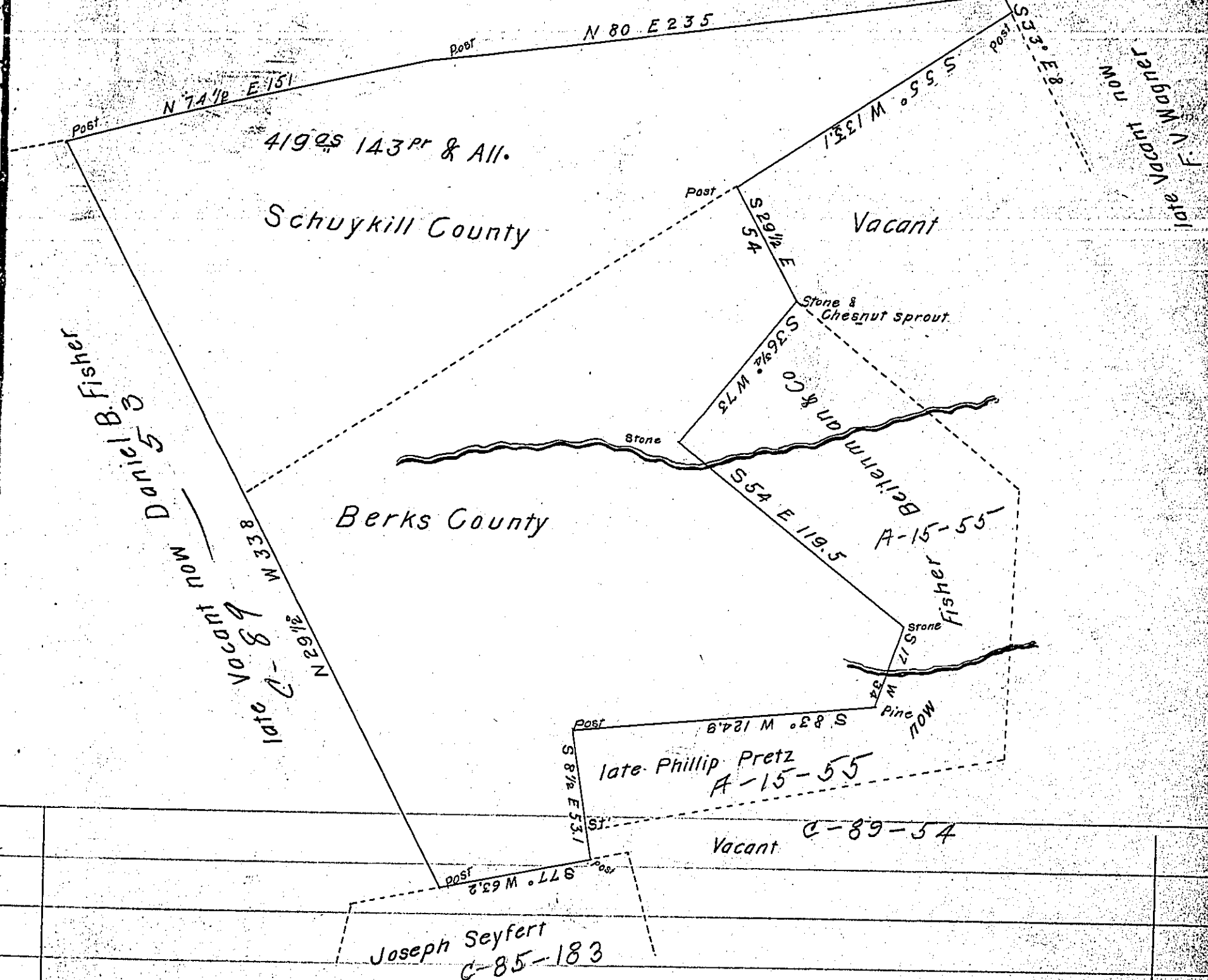


Fisher Beitenman & Co late Huntzinger Royer & Co
