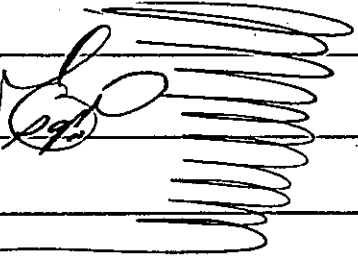


Am Harris
