The above is a draft of a tract of land situated in Wolfscreek Township being a part, and the south end of a larger tract, survey entered in Survey Book, for William Brandon (I believe the settler), containing 40 acres and 15 1/2 perches. Devised the 13<sup>th</sup> of November 1828, in pursuance of a warrant granted to David Courtney bearing date, the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1828, containing one hundred and eighty acres and ninety perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads. Bounded as described above.
