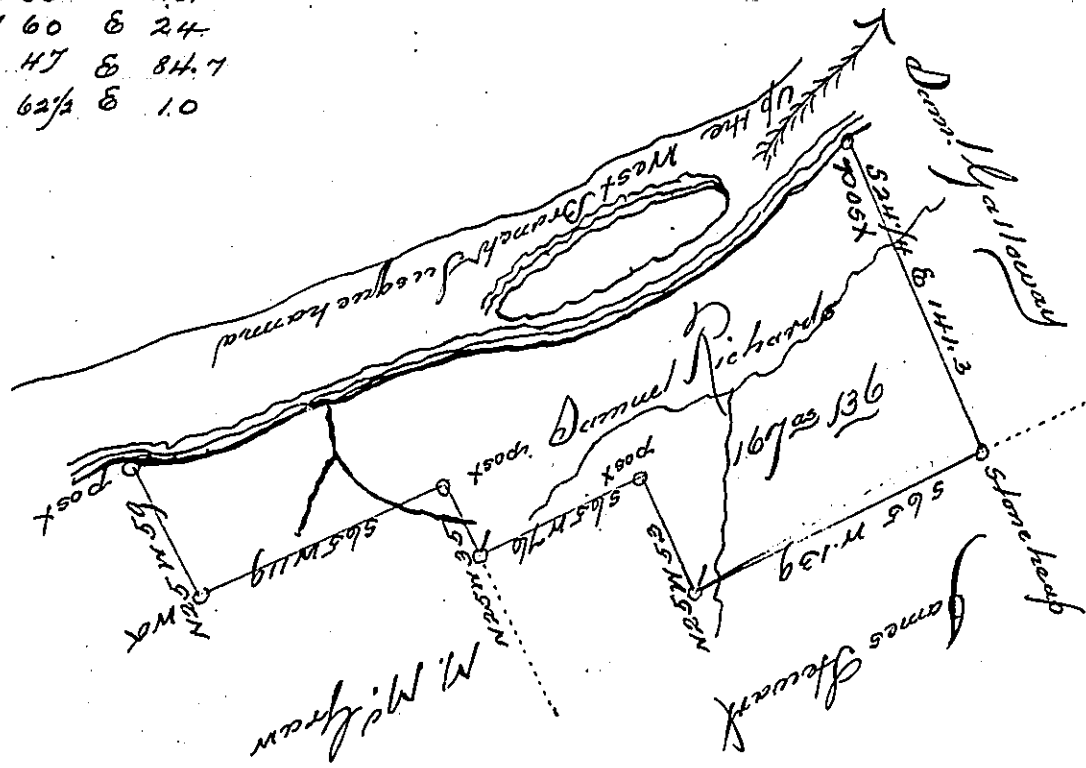

In pursuance of a decree of the Board of Property on the 25th of February 1828, and the order of the Surveyor General, this tract was directed to be resurveyed on the 22^d of March 1828 for the Heirs of Michael Rose, the above described tract of Land, situated in Linton Township Lycoming County, bounded as above described, containing one hundred and sixty seven acres one hundred and thirty six perches and allowance of six perches. Held by virtue of an application in the name of Samuel Richards dated the 3^d day of April 1869 and numbered 765.
