



In pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Campbell dated 15th March 1819 I surveyed the above described tract of land on the 30th of June 1831 containing four hundred and ten acres, forty three perches and the allowance of six per cent. situate in Sugar creek township Armstrong county, being the same tract of land from which Henry Heltzel now resides, and occupies the same as an actual settler and improver bounded by lands surveyed to Charles Campbell on the north (being now lands of Isaac and Simon Fair) lands of Arch^d McCall, Valentine Bouser and others as represented by the above Diagram,
