



Survey'd to Nicholas Coleman on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785 the above described tract of two hundred & seventy three acres & a quarter of an acre and allowance of Six <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Cent Situate on the head waters of Elder's Run that empties into Conemagh, bounded by land of Mr Elder on the South, Robert McClelland on the South West, Thomas Steel on the West, John Marshall on the North & Robert Cochran on the East Including his Improvement in Westmoreland County. By Warrant of the 28<sup>th</sup> Feby 1785
