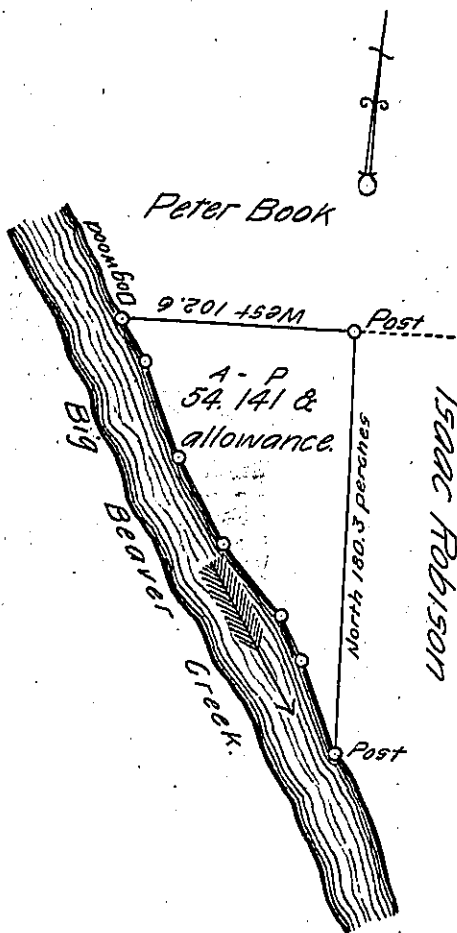

The above is a Draft of a Survey, Executed August 17th A.D. 1824 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Leslie Curtis, Dated April 2nd A.D. 1821. which Warrant is now Transferred, to John Davidson by assignment bearing Date, the 14th day of April, A.D. 1824. Situate on the north side of the Ohio River, lying on the East side Big Beaver Creek North Sewickley Township Beaver County containing 54 acres and 141 perches and allowance of 6 per cent &c.
