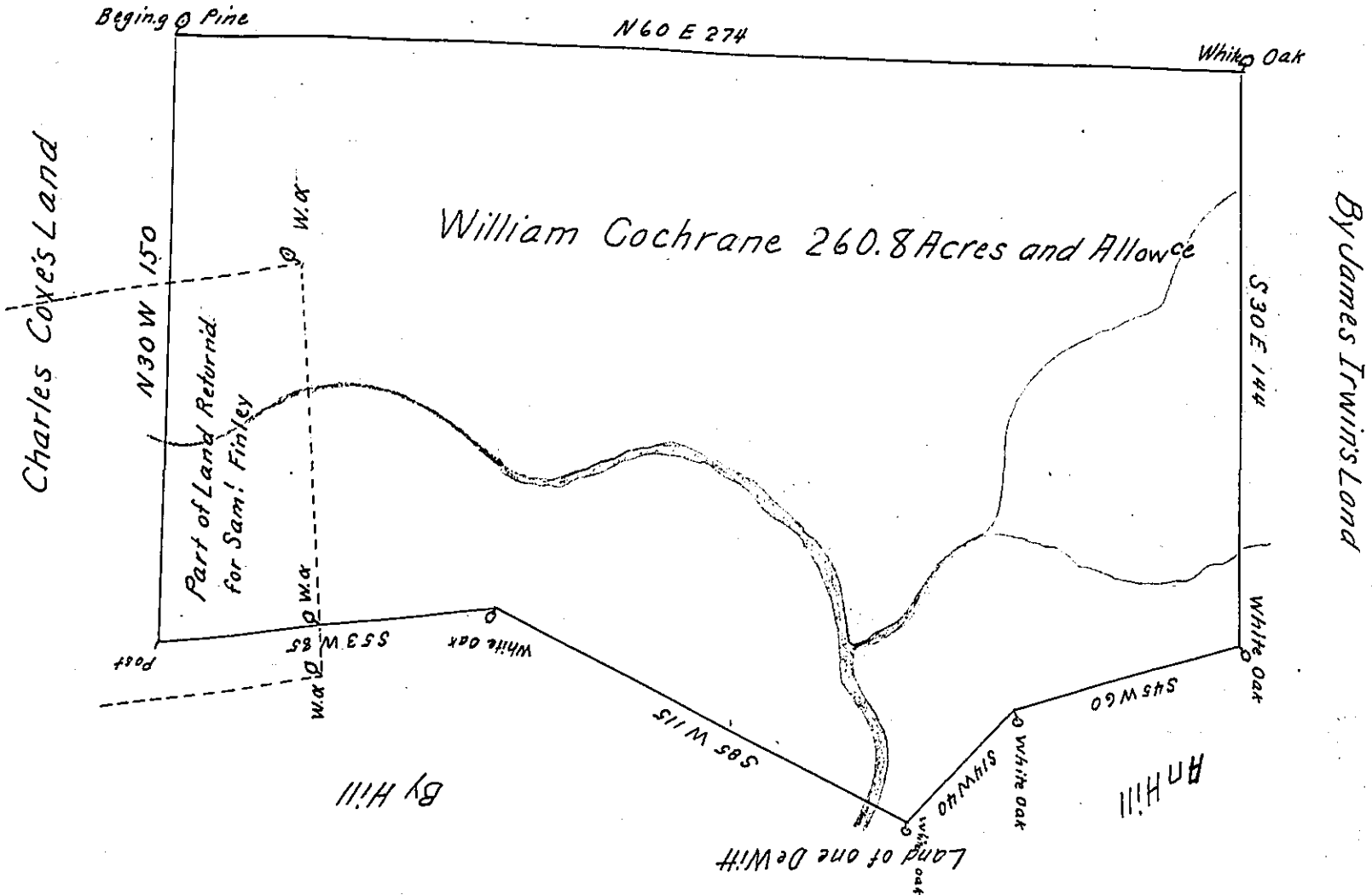


Shade Mountain
