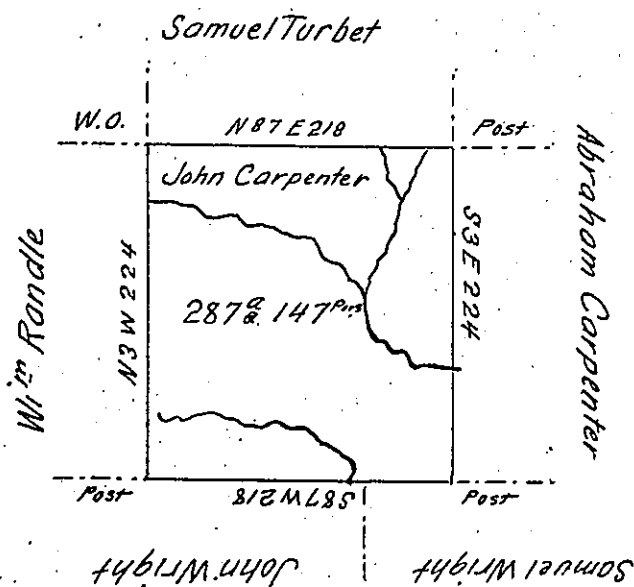

Surveyed the eighth day of October 1794 Two hundred and eighty seven acres and 147 perches of Land with the allowance of Six p. Cent &c. In pursuance of a Warrant granted John Carpenter the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March 1793 Situate in district N<sup>o</sup> 8. N.W. of the Allegheny River on the waters of Buffalo Creek.
