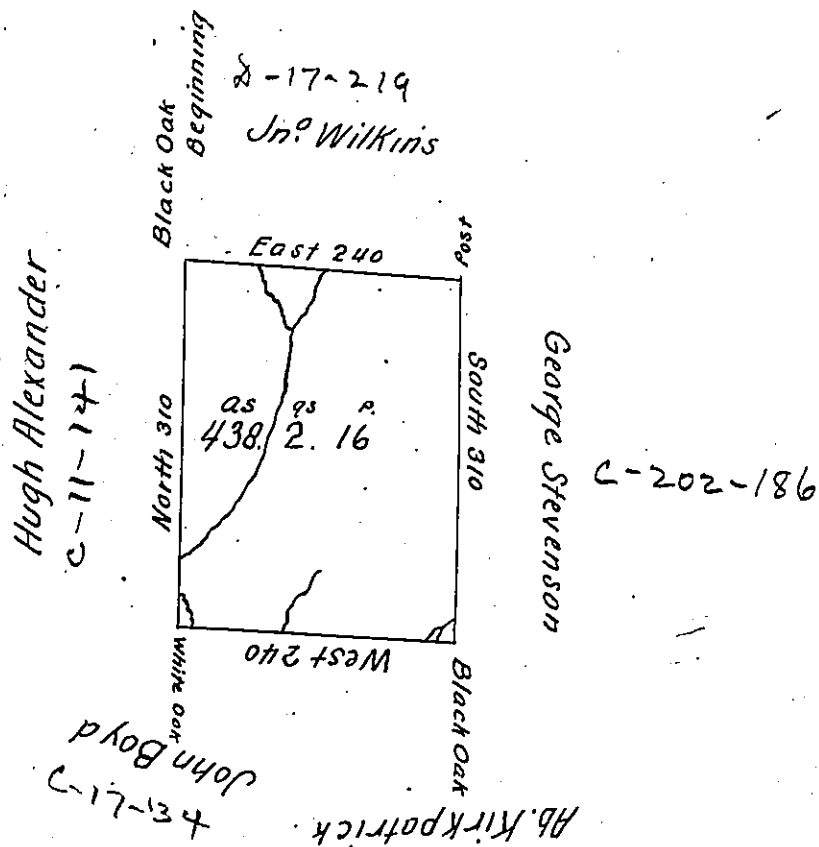

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 4<sup>th</sup> 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Isaac Craig for 400 Acres of Land Dated February the tenth day 1794. Adjoining John Boyd to the Eastward including the head Waters of a Stream which empties into Allegheny North and West of the River Ohio. Allegheny and Conawango Creek Colled Fox Ridge. Containing four Hundred thirty Eight and an half Acres and Sixteen poles together with the Usual allowance of Six pr. Cent.
