

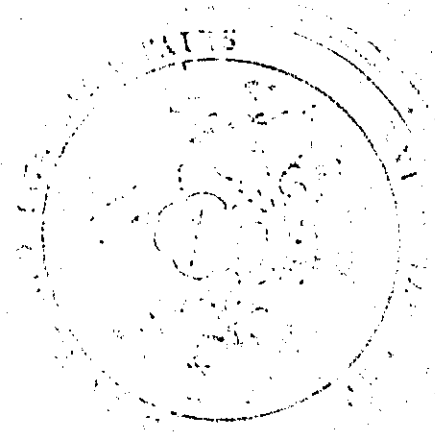

N.B. No Corner exists at the official width given for warrant No. 5947 - as its s. East Cor. but 33 rods short of the official distance, a White Pine Corner occurs, supposed to be the right date (1807) yet having no witnesses, and no original line running north from it, it is assumed however as the s.w. Corner of the Washington Brooks warrant E. P. Goff.
