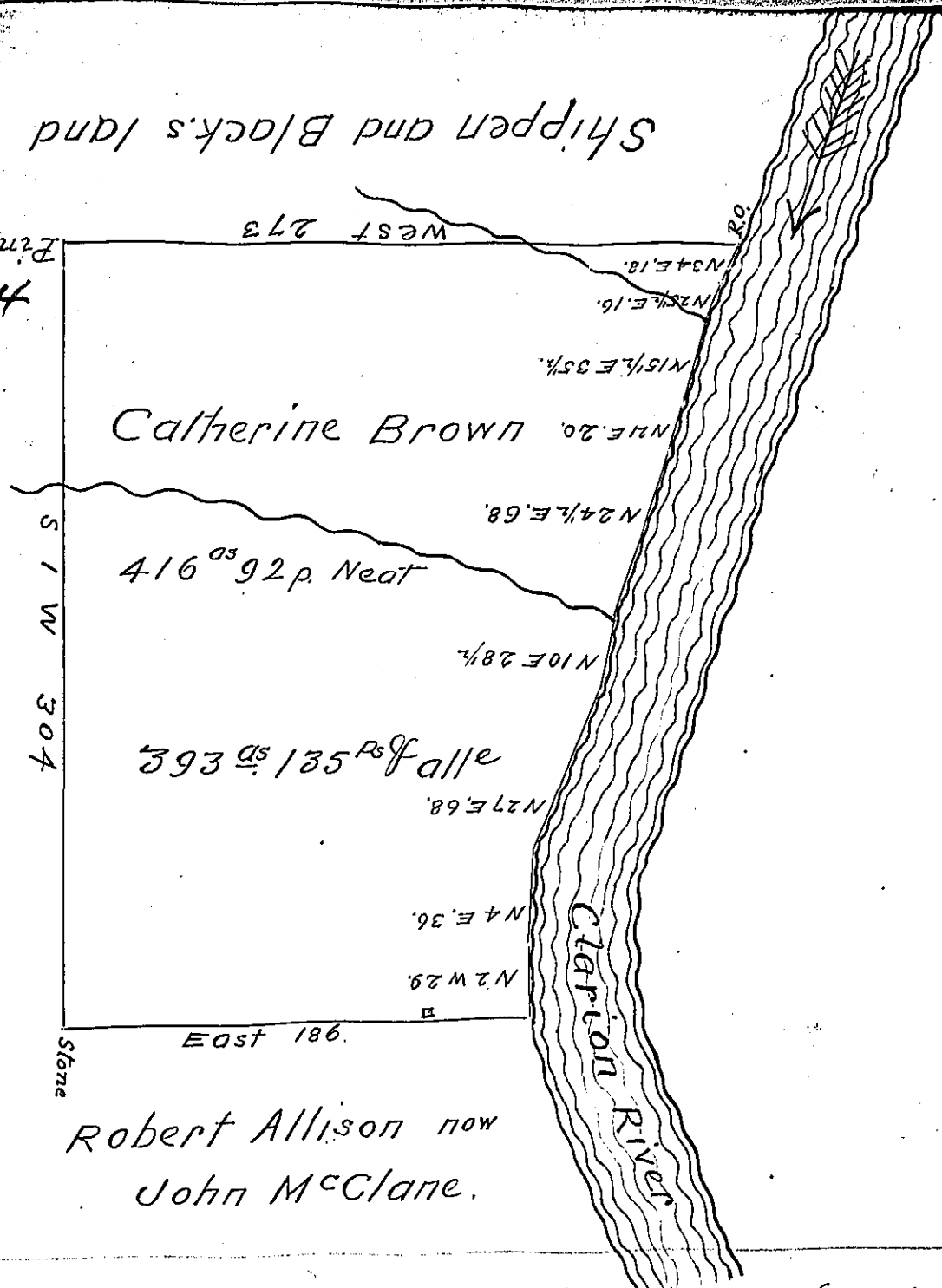

In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1854 granted to Catharine Brown Surveyed upon the 31<sup>st</sup> day of July A.D. 1854 to the aforesaid Catharine Brown the above described Tract of Land situate in Paint Township Clarion County Pa Containing four hundred and sixteen Acres and ninety two per neat for which she has paid into the Office of the State Treasurer the sum of fifty seven dollars and Eighty three Cents Including fees - and also ten dollars paid to Thomas J. Reher in the Land Office for patent fees

The above name-Warrant was directed to me by the Hon<sup>ble</sup> J. Porter Brawley S.G. which I have located and Executed on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 1854
