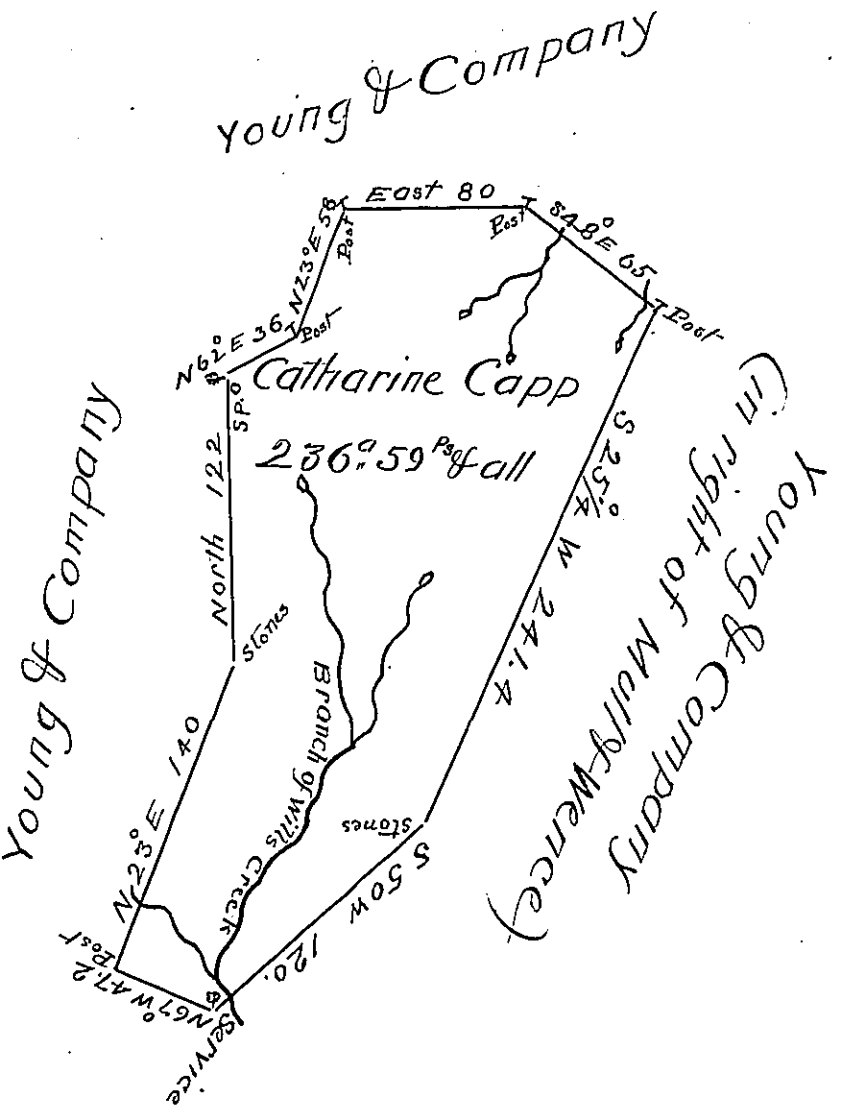

appears by his Official draught remaining in my  
Office - And certified this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September  
1820
