



The above is a draught of a tract of land surveyed March 1st 1817, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Ebenezer Cochran dated February 18th 1785[±] situate on the waters of Racon Creek, Hanover Township, Washington County. Containing one hundred and thirty three acres and eighty perches, with the usual allowance of 6 per cent &c.

N.B. At the time of survey there was no house, nor family residing on the land, there had been about ten acres cleared in the summer of 1816 - I know of no adverse claim whatsoever - James Reed D.S.
