



The above described tract of two hundred and twenty six Acres and fifty six perches and the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. is part of a larger Tract of 324 Acres 52 perches & allowance, situate in Letter Kenny Township Franklin County, which was Surveyed the 27th of May 1785. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Francis Campbell & John Mitchell, bearing date the 7th of July 1784. Resurveyed and laid off the above tract, the 5th of Aug^r 1822, pursuant to an Order from Daniel Brodhead Esq^r (then Surveyor Gen^l) bearing date the 10th of August 1799 Directing a return of separate Drafts according to an amicable Action in Partition, then pending, between Francis Campbell & James Hamilton Esq^r the parties then in interest.
