



The plotted lines above represents the original survey of Michael Campbell which appears from papers filed in the Deputy Surveyor's office in Armstrong County (and from the marks upon the ground) to have been surveyed on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October 1784 on a warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1784.

N. B. the survey appears to have been made by Joshua Elder.

And now To Wit on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1841 resurveyed that part included in the black lines to Martha Sloan containing ninety four acres fifty perches and allowance of six per cent &c. Situate in plumb creek Township Armstrong County
