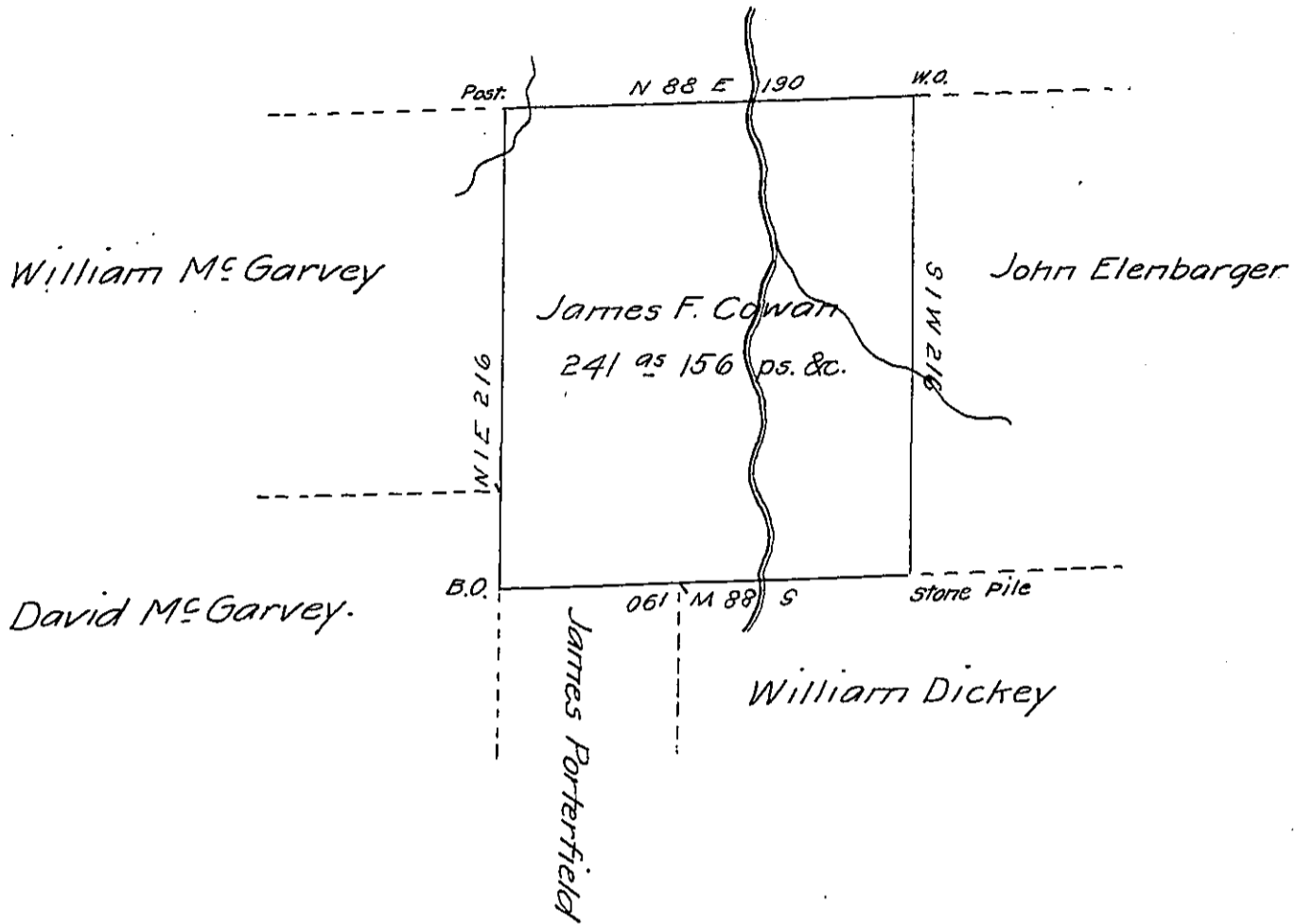


James Mc Clatchey
