



The two small surveys above laid down are situated on Dewitts Run Boggs township Centre Co. to wit the lot containing fifty one acres and allow^{ce} is a part of the W^m Campbell tract. Originally surveyed Nov^r 18th 1794. Warrant dated 27 April 1793 and the small tract of thirty acres & ninety perches is all that remains of the William Boggs tract. Originally surveyed 22nd Nov. 1806. Warrant date 21 October 1806 & Resurv^d 28 August 1849. Order dated 11 Decem^r 1848. the above connection made for Judge Burnside who desires to patent the same in pursuance of a sale made of this property. I have run & marked the above lines, as they are found upon the ground.
