



The above is a draught of a survey made August 8<sup>th</sup> 1828 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Carman dated May 19<sup>th</sup> 1828 for ten acres of land, but contains fifty acres and twenty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for highways situate in Hopewell Township W. C. on the waters of Cross Creek, most of it has been improved for about 21 years.
