



*Draught of one hundred and ten acres and ninety four perches of land with six per Cent for roads. Situate in Fermanough township in Mifflin County which appears to have been surveyed 29<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> August 1795 in pursuance of a warrant to Joseph Cook son dated 9<sup>th</sup> November 1786. Said to contain 106 acres and 112 perches. Resurveyed first November 1809 and found to contain as above mentioned.*
