Situate in the— of Yohagania on Hermons run. to Include his Settlement made in the Year 1775 also a Right in Preemption to One Thousand Acres adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Cox's fort the 18th day of January 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
