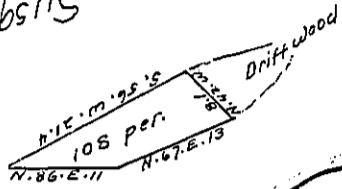

The draft of an Island Situate in the Township of lower Mahanoy in the County of Northumberland called Driftwood Island and next above the cow Island & oppisite the farm of the said John Blasser on the East and the farm of Frederick Herrold on the west, about eighty yards from the east shore of the river Susquehanna, Containing One hundred and eight perches strict measure surveyed unto John Blasser Junr. on the 24th. September 1813 by virtue of his warrant dated the 11th. February 1813
