



The Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Miles Township Centre County Containing Sixty Six Acres, one hundred & forty perches and allowance of Six per Cent - Surveyed the 21st day of October 1814 In pursuance of a warrant granted to Catharine Bierly dated the 19th day of July 1814.

At the time of making this Survey Catharine Bierly and her family resided on the above described tract of land lived in a Cabin House and had about four or five Acres of Cleared land on the same - she says the improvement was first made in Octr. 1811
