



Situate in Greenwich Township, Berks County Containing Forty two acres, one hundred and thirty four perches and the allowance of six per Cent for roads & part of a larger tract of one hundred and twenty two acres & forty six perches & allow. surveyed to Jacob Branstedner the 10th. of August 1748 & by warrant dated the 12th. of May 1758 - divided the 6th. October 1815 for Jacob Grim.
