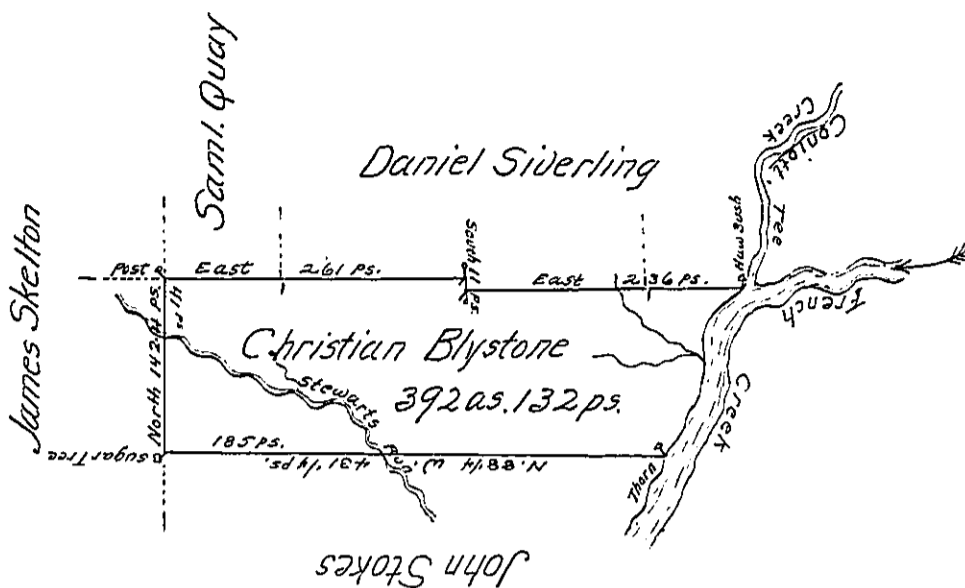

In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres of land dated the 5th day of July 1814 was surveyed October the 12th. 1814 for Christian Blystone the above described Tract of Land Containing Three hundred ninety two acres one Hundred thirty two perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads - &c. Situate in Venang Township in the County of Crawford - and at the time of Making said survey, the said Christian Blystone was actually Living on the same - with his family - and there apaced that, there was upwards of one hundred acres of the land Cleared fenced and In a good state of Cultivation
