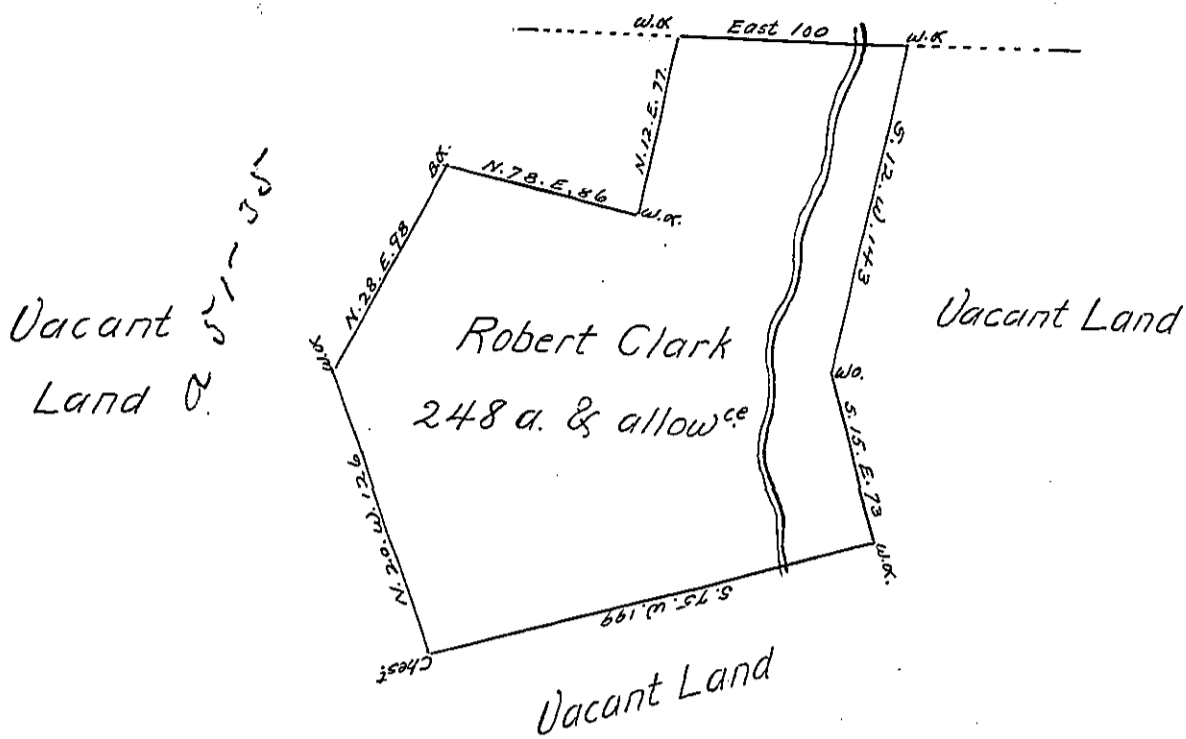

The above described Tract of Two hundred & forty eight acres & the usual allowance of Six pCt. Situate on a Run that empties into the North Side of Kiskaminates a little above Warrans Sleeping Place & about two miles up said Run Including a Bald Hill & a Spring at the South Side of said Hill in Westmorland County By Warrant of the 10th. Day of September 1773.
