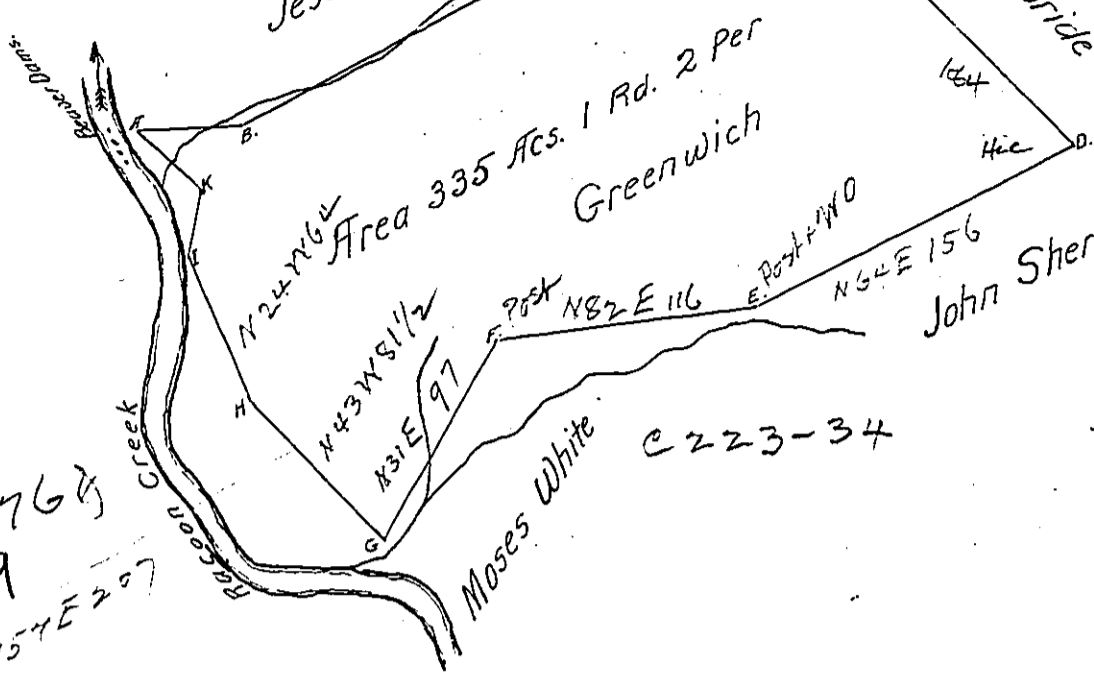

We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohiogany and Ohio do hereby certify that Richd. Chamberlain is entitled to four hundred Acs. of Land in the County ~~in ye County~~ of Yohiogany situate on the waters of Raccoon to include his settlement made in the year 1775.

Given under our Hands at Cox's Fort the 4th day of Feby. 1780 & in the 4th year of the Commonwealth.
