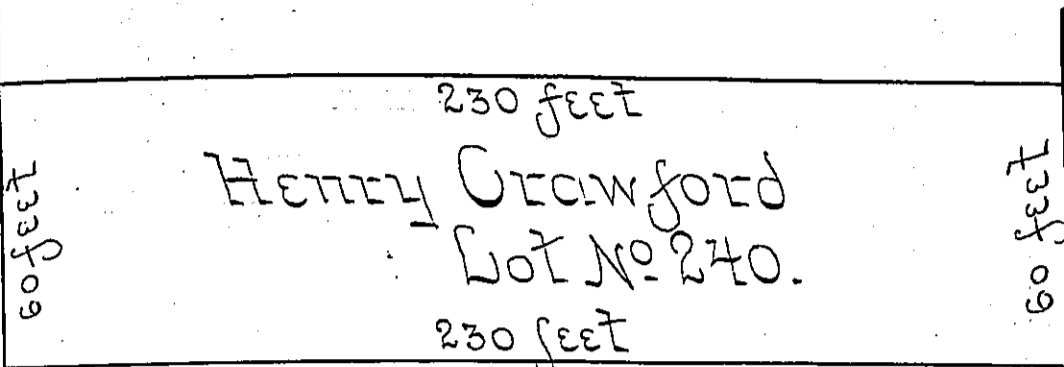


Gooseberry Alley

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissione
 of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey
 was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Claron Wright on
 a certain lot of ground situate in the Town of Sum-
 bury in the County of Northumb^d marked in a
 General Plan of said Town Number Two Hundred
 and forty Containing in Breadth East and West
 on the North side of Pockberry Street Sixty feet,
 and in length North and South Two Hundred and
 Thirty feet Bounded Southward by Pockberry
 Street Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and
 Thirty Nine Northward by Gooseberry Alley and West-
 ward by Center Alley Returned into the Secretary's
 Office the 22^d day of March 1776 for Henry Craw-
 ford by Warrant dated the 10th of the same Month

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
