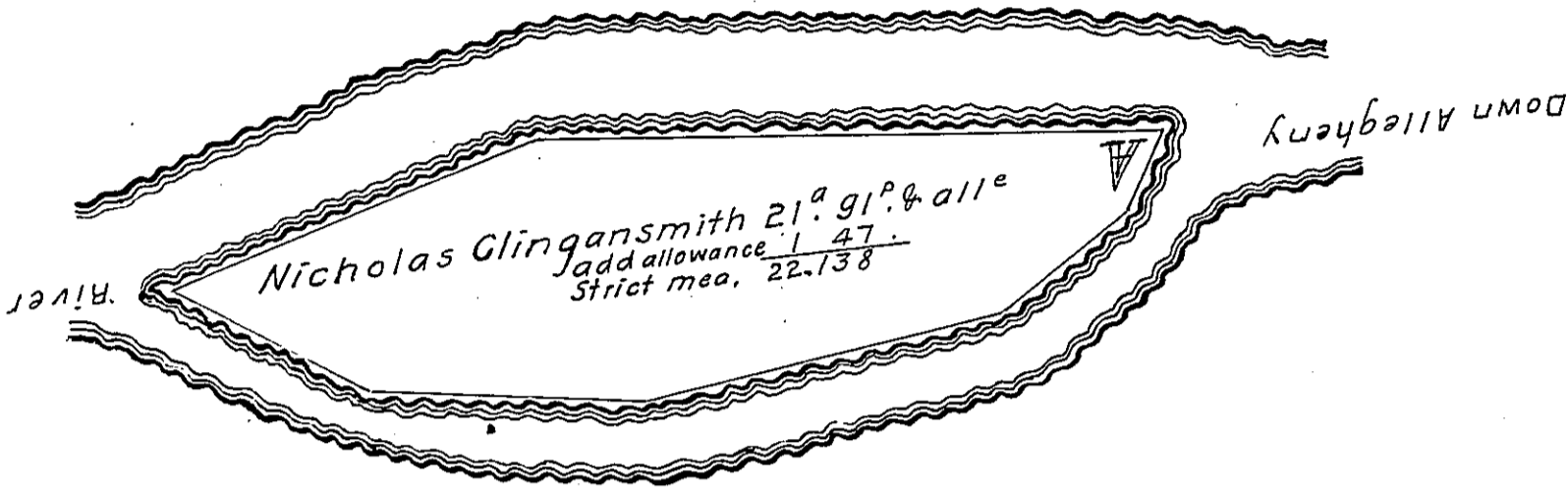

Surveyed to Nicholas Clingansmith on the 14 day of June 1812 the above described Island Containing twenty one acres and Ninety one perches with an allowance\* of Six per Cent & c. By virtue of a Warrant dated Decem<sup>r</sup>. 19<sup>th</sup> 1811 Situate about two Miles & one half above the Mouth of Kiskiminities river and opposite to Samuel Murphys farm on the N.W. Side of the Allegheny river, Armstrong County -
