



The above is a draught of a Survey made November 8th day 1816 containing 83 acres and 80 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. in pursuance of a Warrant granted William Brock bearing date the 20th day of September 1816 Situate in Wayne Township Greene County on a branch of Robert's Run. Called "Brock's choice"
