



From field notes in my possession the above described tract of land appears to have been Surveyed for Dam! Campie & Mary Nichols in Trust for the heirs of Hugh Nichols, dec'd. on the 27th of October, 1785, by Virtue of a Warrant granted the 27th of Sept. 1785, Containing two hundred and eighty-nine acres, one hundred & fiftynine perches & allowance of six feet &c. situated in Pinecreek Township, Lycoming County bounded as above described & now returned at request of the owner.
