



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland for John Solomon numbered in a General Plan of said Town One hundred and fifty two Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street aforesaid, Westward by River Alley, Southward by Mulberry Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and fifty one, Returned into the Secretary's Office the 30th day of August 1773 for Margaret Duncan by Warrant dated the 2^d day of January last.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of July 1904.
