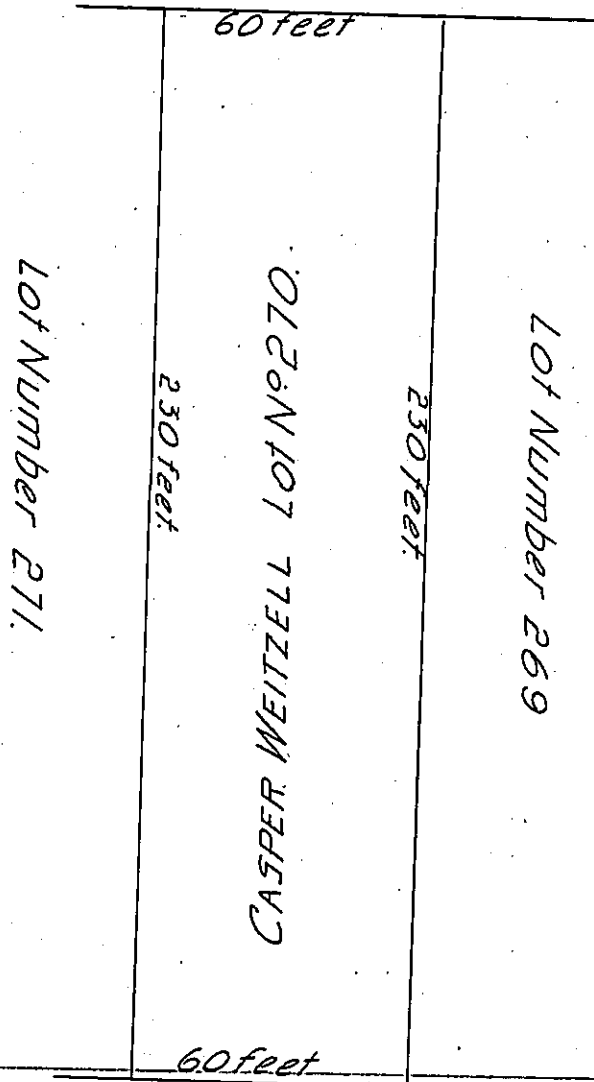


Poakberry Street.

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commission^{er} of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Casper Weitzell on a Certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and seventy Containing in Breadth East and West on Poakberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Poakberry Street afore said, Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and sixty nine, Southward by Raspberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and seventy One. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 30th day of January 1775 for Philip Dahn by Warr^t dated the 26th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourteenth day of July 1904.
