



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for James Duncan on a Certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Ninety Containing ^{110 1/2} Breadth North and South on Fawn Street Sixty feet, and in Length East and West Two Hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Fawn Street, Northw^d by Lot Number One Hundred and Eighty Nine, Eastward by Meadow Alley, and Southward by Lot Number One Hundred and Ninety One. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 23^d day of April 1776 for David Duncan.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighteenth day of July 1904
