



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for George Swartz on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and Nineteen. Containing in Breadth East & West Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Poakberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and Eighteen, Southward by Raspberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and Twenty. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 13th day of May 1776 for Christopher Dunckleberger.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighteenth day of July 1904.
