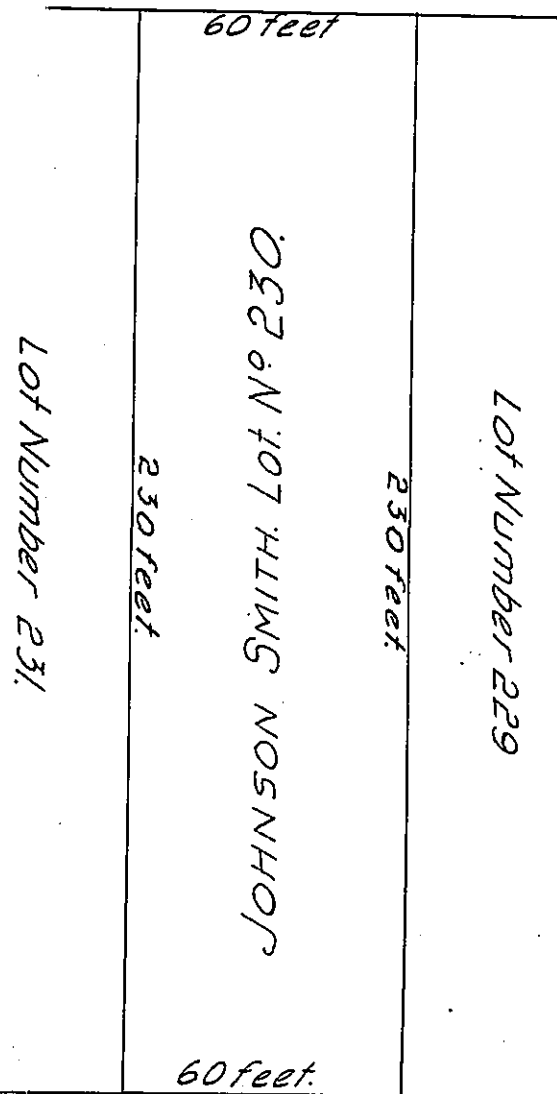


Blackberry Street.



Gooseberry Alley

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Johnson Smith on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two ^{hundred} and Thirty. Containing in Breadth East and West on Blackberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North & South Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Blackberry Street Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Twenty Nine Southward by Gooseberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Thirty One. Returned into the Secretary's Office the day of July 1776 for John Deal by Warrant dated the 24th day of July 1776.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-sixth day of July 1904.
