



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for James McCausland on a Certain Lot of Ground, Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two Hundred and Sixty, Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet, and in length North & South Two Hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Hurtleberry Street. Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and fifty Nine, Northward by Raspberry Alley, and Westward by River Street. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 26th day of August 1776 for John Dunkleberger.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-sixth day of July 1904.
