



Situate in Paradise Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth Eighty Acres and allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of 199^{ac} & 18 Perches and allowance which was Originally Surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 21st day of July A.D. 1797 to John Heidler In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Melchor Carver bearing date the 22^d day of May A.D. 1751. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 11th day of May Anno Domini 1807. for John Heidler the Younger, the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught To Andrew Porter Esq. Per Jacob Spangler D. S. Surveyor General N. B. It is probable the whole of which this is Lancaster Pa a part was Returned in the name of John Heidler in right of the said Melchor Carver.
