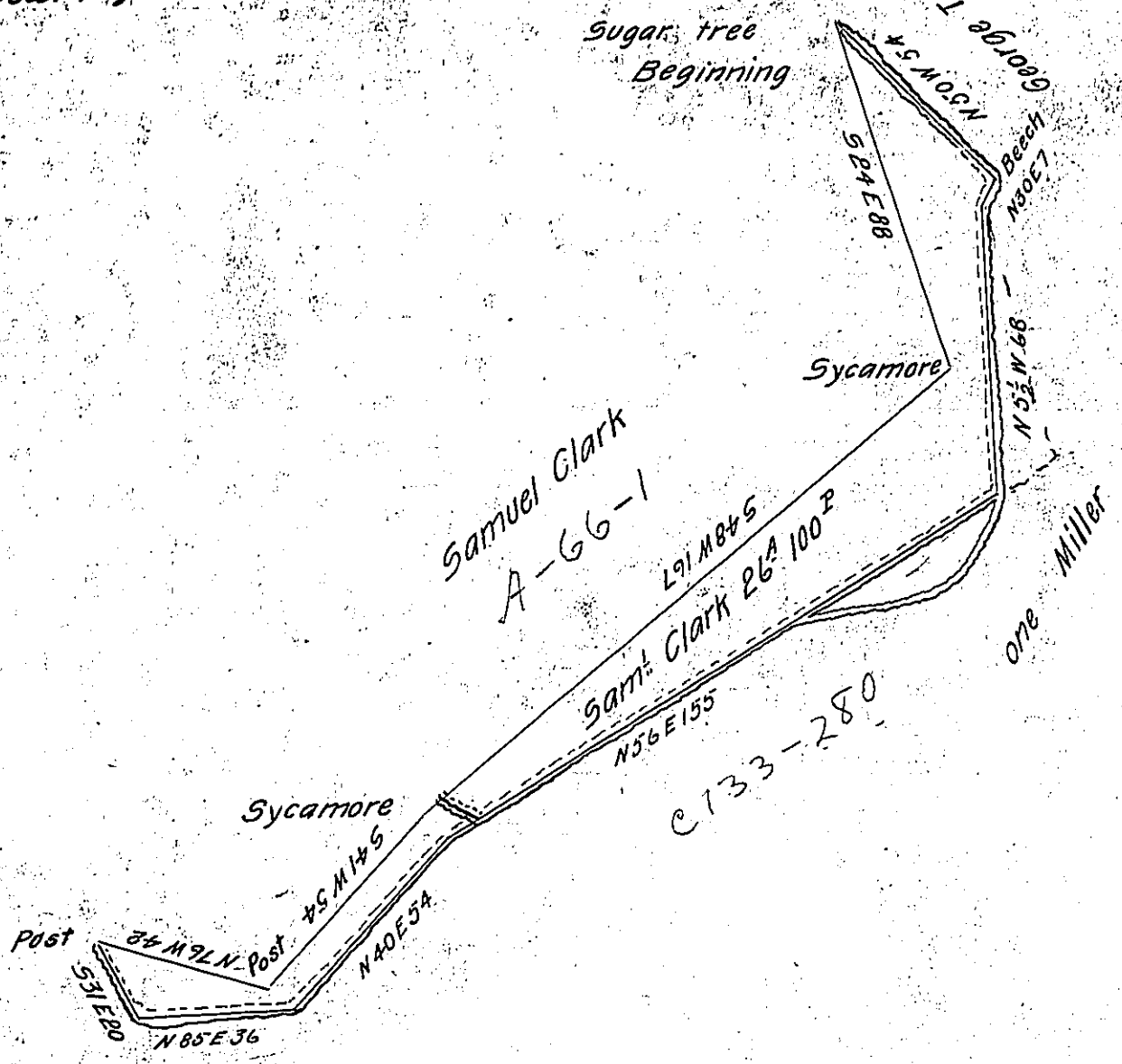


No Vacant Land between Grove + Cedar Hill Surv + Pat

Situate in East Bethelam Township on ten Mile Creek part in Washington County and part in Greene County Called Grove Containing twenty Six Acres and one hundred perches with the Usual Allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads
