Situate on the waters of the Cowanesque about one quarter of a mile above a large branch that passes the State line near the 109 Mile Stone and about one Quarter of a mile from the main Branch of the Cowanesque in the County of Tioga Containing Eighty one Acres forty perches & ~~the~~ allowance of 6 Pr. Ct.
