



Situate in York Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 20<sup>acres</sup> & 110 Perches and the usual allowance of six Per Cent &c. being part of a larger Tract of 63<sup>acres</sup> & 136 Perches and allowance of Land, which was Originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> Month 1788. In Pursuance of a warrant for sixty acres Granted to Henry Dolman bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1787. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract by the said William Kersey on the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> Month 1792. And now at the request of the Present owner Caleb Kirk the above has been calculated examined &c. and found to be Correct and at his request returned for Confirmation the 24<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1813.
