



Situate in Warrior mark Township Huntingdon was first surveyed the seventh of November 1804 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Elisha Davis Dated the 15th Day of May 1804 and was said to Contain four hundred and five acres & 105 perches and allowance & Resurveyed the 17th day of December 1813 & several Interferences with older surveys struck off the Residue Contains three hundred and Eighteen acres 34 perches and allowance done in pursuance of an order of Resurvey granted to the said Elisha Davis Dated the 2nd Day of March 1813.
