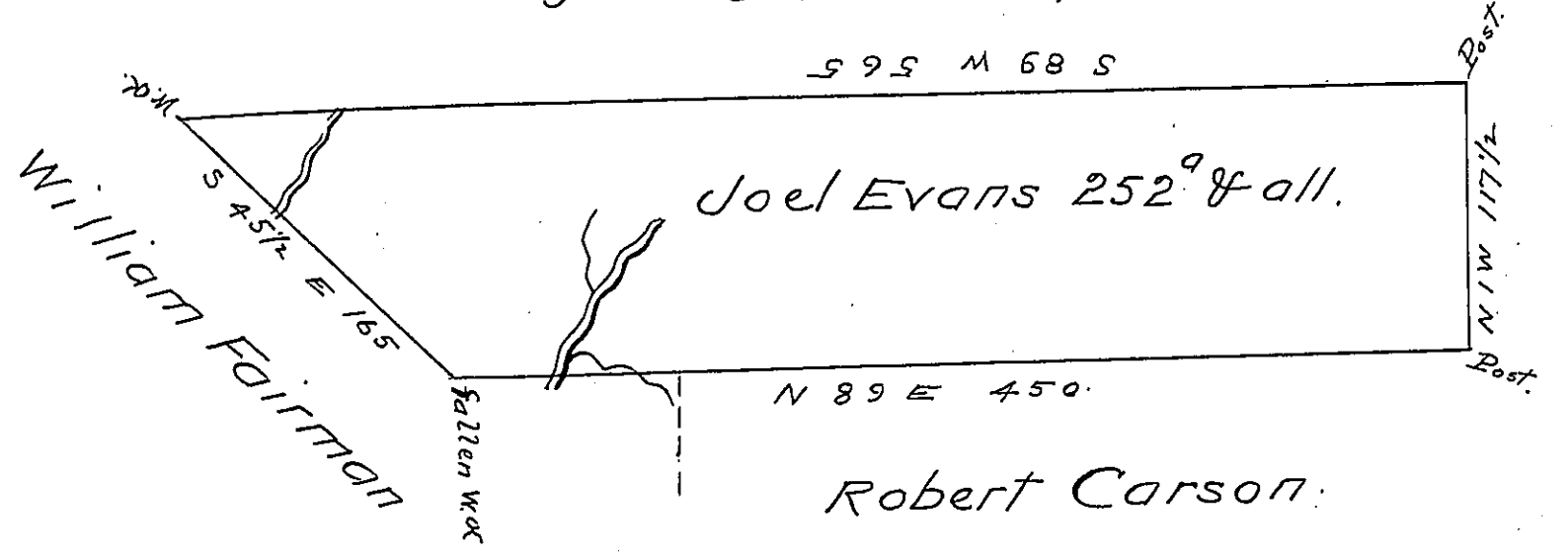

By Virtue of an Order of the Surveyor General dated the 15th day of November 1796: and in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 16th day of August 1773 there was Surveyed on the 21st day of November 1796 unto Joel Evans 372⁹/₆₅ perches of Land and allowance then Situate on some small branches of Little Fishing Creek in Northumberland County, but now in Mountpleasant Township Columbia County by William Montgomery then deputy Surveyor and now to wit on the 23^d day of December 1823 Resurveyed and Examined by me and I find the Contents to be agreeably to the old lines Two hundred and fifty two acres and allowance.
