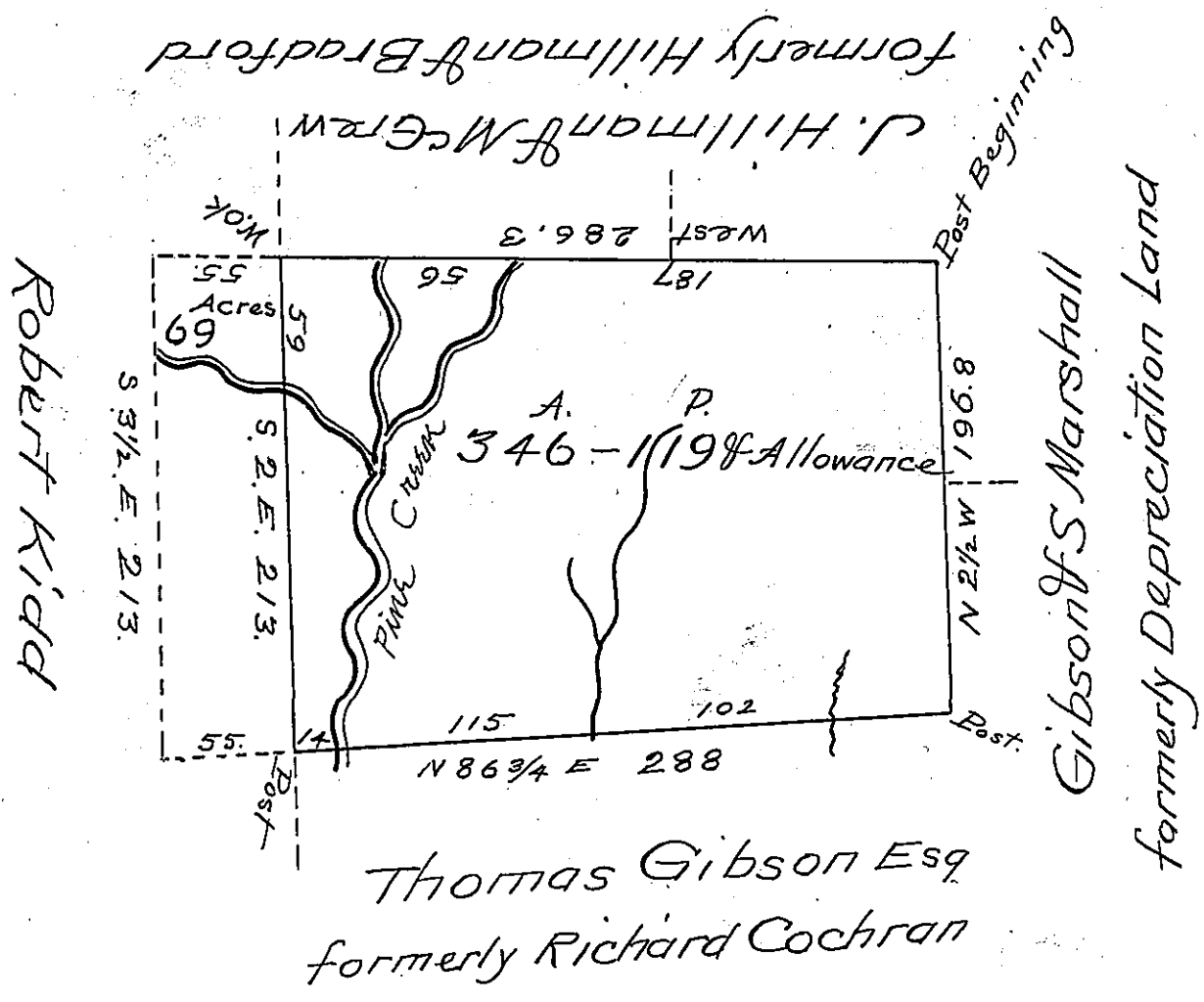

The above is a Draught of a Survey made March 15th 1837 for the heirs of John Emmitt Decd. Containing three hundred & forty six Acres and 119 perches & Allowance of six percent. Situate in Pine Township Allegheny County on the waters of Pine Creek. the whole represents an Original Survey made April 29th 1813 on a Warrant granted to John Emmitt for 400 Acres Dated March 23^d 1813. the Dotted lines represent a part of Emmitts Survey Cut off from him by Robert Kidd & embraced (now) in Kidds Survey & contains about 69 Acres & Allowance the rest is undisputed and is owned and occupied by the Widow and Children of John Emmitt Decd. the improvement appears to be old
