



Situate in Hopewell Township Huntingdon County containing three hundred and six acres 108 perches and allowance surveyed the 3^d day of June 1765 on a warrant granted to Thomas Brandon dated October 29th 1762 it then contained 526 1/4 acres - divided from the residue of said tract the see and day of November 1813.
