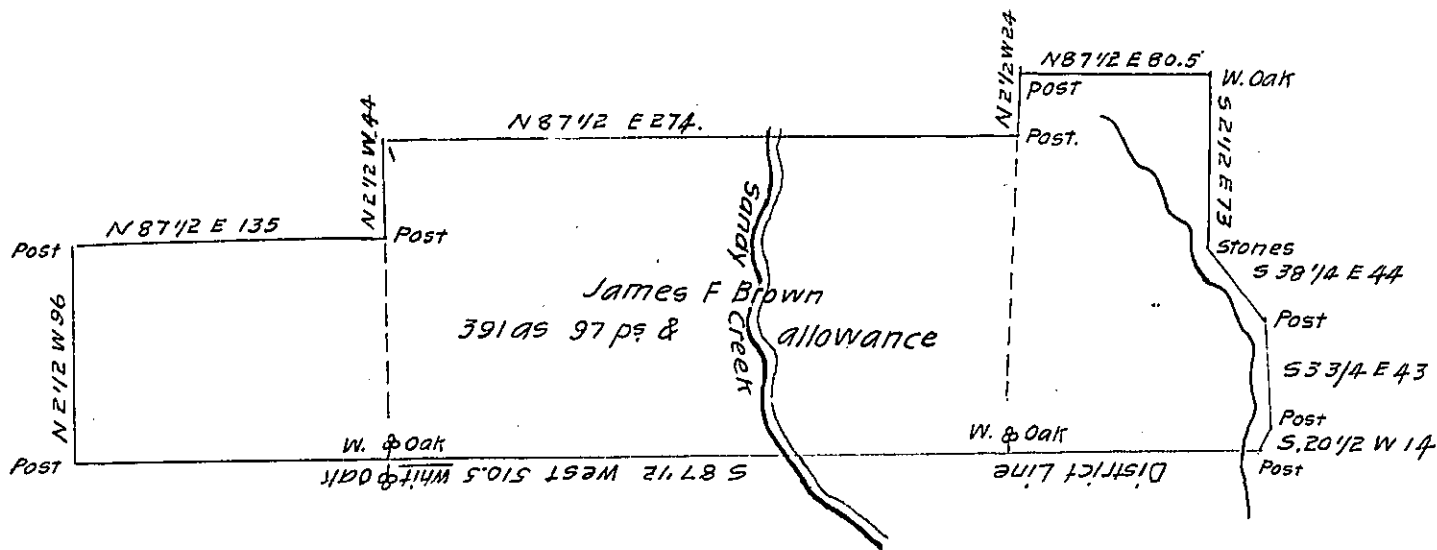

The above is the draft of a Tract of land situate in Sandy Lake Township Mercer County Surveyed for James Finley Brown in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Craig dated the eighteenth day of December 1794. Being one of seven Warrants, authorized to be located and Patents To to ^{issue} in favour of Alexander Wright &c. By act of Assembly passed the 6th day of April 1833. Surveyed on the 11th day of November B. 37. Bounded as above described & Con-Containing three hundred and ninety one acres & 97 perches with the usual allowance of six per obl for Roads. There is no adverse claim to the above land.

Note. The above mentioned Warrant was sold, transfered and assigned regularly by Alexr. Wright to James F. Brown on the 27th day of December 1836 as appears on said Warrant duly acknowledged &c. March 25th 1838.
