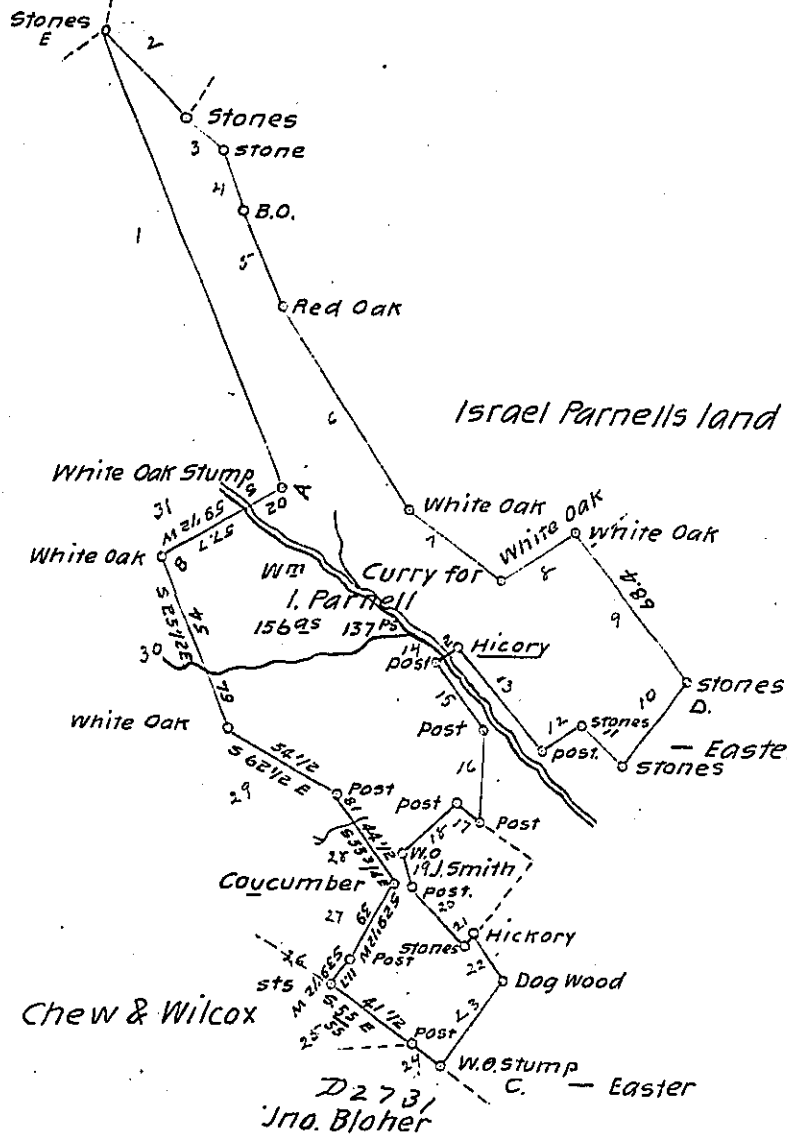

It has on it two Log cabins, one log dwelling house & log barn, has about 40 acres cleared & appears to have been settled about 40 years & now in the occupancy of Israel Parnell.
