



Situate on the West side of the Youghiogeni in Wharton township Fayette County Pa and surveyed the 29th of May 1817. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the first day of May 1804 by my predecessor A. McClean

Note there is a double Cabbin about 30 feet by 18 a new house 24 feet by 20 a stable 60 acres cleared and under fence One hundred bearing apple trees and a family residing on the premises at the time the survey was made
