



Survey'd to Thomas Cummins on the 10th — — May 1786 the above Described Tract of one hundred and sixty nine acres & three Quarters of an acre & allowance of six Per Cent situate on a branch of Plumb Creek about six Miles to the East of the old Kittanning Path leading from Legonier to the Kittanning Town, about one mile from where it empties into Plumb Creek, in Westmoreland County By warrant of the 13th December 1773.
