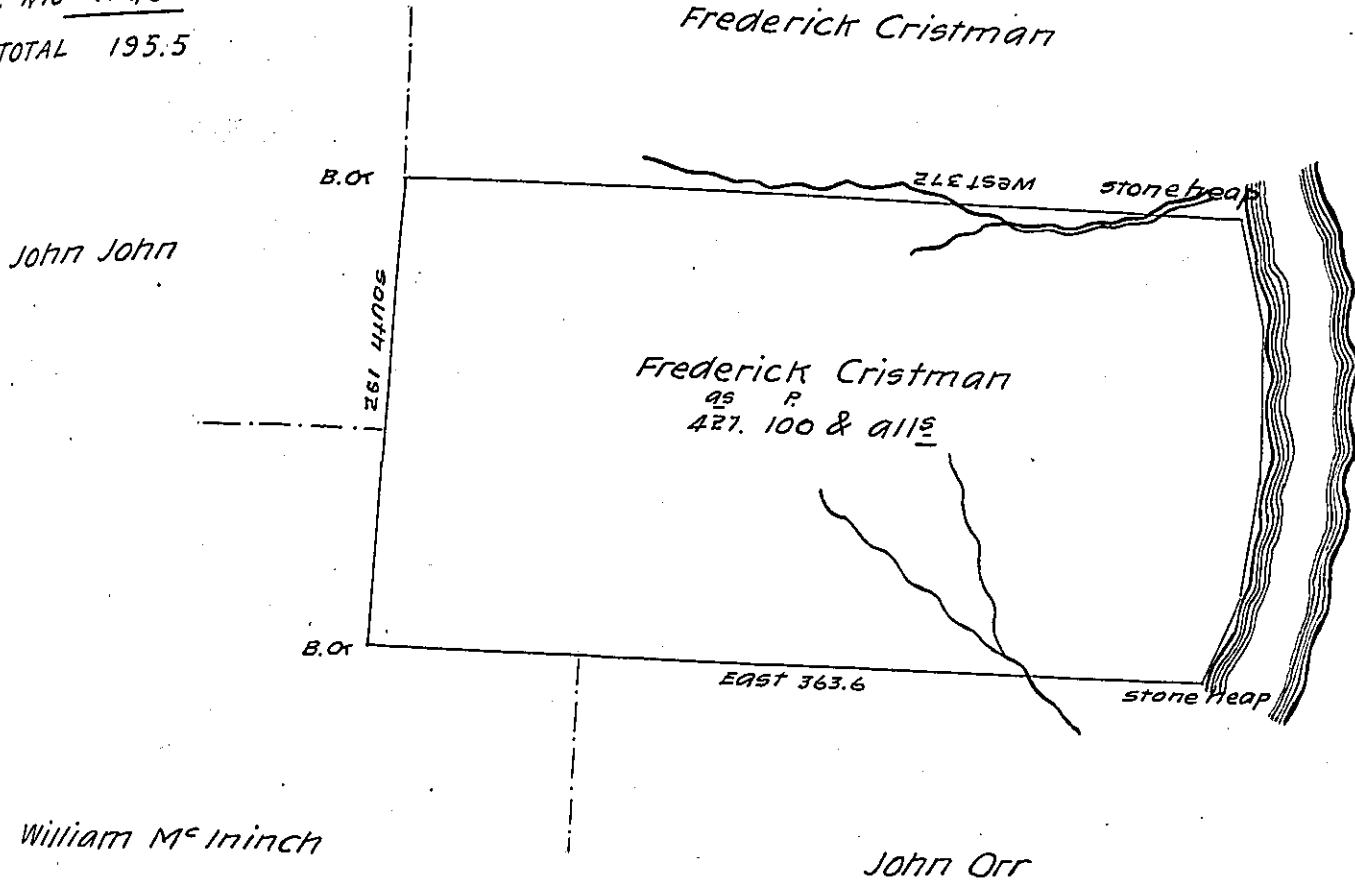


Courses and distances up the Allegheny river
